

## Facts about Mandaville, Jamaica Trip

### When is the trip?

The date is yet to be determined, but it likely will be in late May or early June of 2016

### How many people can go on this trip?

Only about 10-12 will be allowed to go on this trip, unless there are great enough numbers to warrant a second group.

### Who is eligible to go on the trip?

Any registered adult member of the St. Paul or St. Elizabeth churches may go on this. Those age 14-18 may possibly have an opportunity to go ONLY if one of their parents goes with as well, and assuming that there is room. Others will be allowed only if there is extra room.

### Do I need a passport to go on this trip?

Yes, you do need a passport to enter Jamaica. This should be taken care of soon. Anyone who does not produce a valid passport within a month of the trip may be subject to be bumped from the trip.

### Do I need a visa for this trip?

No, one does not need a Visa to go to Jamaica.

### Do I need immunizations to go to Jamaica?

There are no immunizations required for this trip. Some may choose to get an update on their tetanus shot, or to get other preventative shots, but this is up to you.

### How much does this trip cost.

This is yet to be determined, but the *likely* costs of the trip are:

The total cost for the trip is about \$1000. This includes the following expenses:

Room, board and transportation within Jamaica: \$400

One trip to a nice restaurant: \$30

Plane Trip: \$500- \$550

### What about the flight information:

We will likely be flying out of Louisville, into Kingston, Jamaica. Specific plans for the flight will be made once we have a set group going with us.

### What will we need to bring?

It will likely be quite hot in Jamaica, so plan on dressing for warm weather. Often, people arrive with full suitcases of clothes, and other supplies and return from Jamaica with very little. We may end up doing this, so keep that in mind in packing. You should bring mostly work or casual clothes, and only a small amount of dress clothes. Also it is recommended that you bring any personal hygiene products, as they may be tough to get in Jamaica.

### Can I go on this trip if I went last time?

Those who went last time are welcomed on this trip, but we will try to give preference to those who have not yet had this opportunity. This question will be discerned once people are signed up, to accommodate as many as possible.
