## A SHIFT IN GEARS- GEARING UP FOR THE HONEYFEST

This too is both an opportunity, and a test, of the strength of the St. Elizabeth community. This year will present a few challenges to us. I believe that the Lord puts challenges before us for a good reason, so that we can lift one another up. Some challenges are:

- 1)Our chicken cooking crew. As I had mentioned, we will largely need to replace the chicken crew that we have had for years. We are looking for worthwhile new (or antique) articles that can either be auctioned off by themselves, or used as part of a packet.

I believe that St. Elizabeth, with faith in the Lord, can do this.

## WANT YOUR VOICE TO BE HEARD- HERE IS HOW

After the council has heard your ideas, they will then take the opportunity to discuss them (either with or without the presenter present). They will then decide to either go with the idea, or decide against it, or to take further time to examine it more closely.
- Talking about ideas behind people’s back is not helpful. Let us use the community that we have and the system set into place to help our parishes to grow, reach out to others, and to follow the mission that the Lord has for us.
