#### **VOTE ON THE PAINTING**

The St. Elizabeth parish council has been examining the possibility of getting someone to paint the interior of the church side of the building. This will also include patching up drywall in various places, as well as covering over water stains. The quote that we got for doing this job is \$13,000. The parish council had some question on whether this job is necessary and worth doing. Rather than making the decision themselves, they decided to poll the people from the parish. So, that being the case, we will give the people of the parish the opportunity to make this decision. On Sunday, March 3, after mass, each adult who is a registered member of the parish (18 and over) will have to opportunity to cast a vote in favor or against this project. Voting will ONLY be done that one day. If anyone else who is a member of the parish knows that they will not be here that day, and would like to vote, they will need to contact either Glenda or Fr. Steve BEFORE next Sunday. The parish council has determined that they will go with whatever the parish as a whole decides. We thank you for your cooperation on this.

#### YOUTH MINISTER STILL BEING SOUGHT, STIPEND AVAILABLE

In our continuing quest for a person to fill the youth ministry position, we are still looking for someone to come forward to take this job. We will be offering a stipend for this of \$4000 annually, for whoever is willing and qualified to take this job. If more than one person decides to share the job, the stipend will be split between them.

We have had excellent participation in our youth program since we started back after COVID, regularly having around 12-15 kids a night in most cases. Some of these gatherings have been high school only, some open to all of the kids, and recently we had a middle school only gathering. So we have the kids who are willing to come and join us. Now we just need someone to guide them. If you are interested in looking at this position, please talk with Fr. Steve.

#### FISH FRY- LETS GET SOME HELP, LETS HAVE SOME FUN

I am looking forward to doing this fish fry. It is something totally different than anything that we have ever done (yes, it is not part of the "we have always done it this way" mode). So, that being the case, we will need some help on it. Nothing to overburden anyone on, but if plenty of people help, we can get it together. We need:

- 1) People to bring deep fryers. If you have one to loan us, I ask that you bring it ASAP to the church rectory. Please put a sticker on it with your name on it. I would like to have these early, so we know if we have enough.
- 2) People to cook- preferably Knights of Columbus who have done this before and know what to do. It won't be as involved as usual, but we can use them early in the afternoon
- 3) If you want to bring a dessert or a dish to pass, you are very welcome to do so (nothing with meat in it).
