Pastor's Corner

Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe November 24, 2024

Feast of Christ the King: Some years ago divers located a 400-year old sunken ship off the coast of Northern Ireland. Among the treasures they found on that ship was a man's wedding ring. When they cleaned the ring up, they noticed that it had an inscription on it. Etched on the wide band were two hands holding a heart. Under the etching were these words: "I have nothing more to give you." Of all the treasures found on that sunken ship, none moved the divers more than that ring and its beautiful inscription. The etching on that ring and its inscription could have been placed at the top of the cross of Jesus. We read in the gospel of John chapter 15: "No one has greater love than this – to lay down one's life for one's friends." For on that cross Jesus gave us everything he had. He gave us his love. He gave us his life. He gave us ALL, everything - that ONE person could possibly give to another. Today, the last Sunday in the liturgical year, we celebrate and confess Christ as our king. Our King will be always with his people. Let us adore the King and may He rule our lives always.

Feast of St Andrew: On Saturday November 30th Church celebrates the feast of Apostle and Martyr St. Andrew. His name Andrew in Greek means "manly, courageous". He was the son of Jona and was the elder brother of St. peter. Initially he was a disciple of John the Baptist, but when Jesus was pointed out to him as the Messiah, he immediately sought out his brother Peter, and with a sublime faith followed Jesus. After the resurrection of the Lord Andrew preached the Gospel in western Asia Minor (Turkey). Andrew was martyred during the reign of Nero by being tied to a cross made like the letter X. In this way it was hoped to prolong his suffering, and in fact, Andrew is known to have continued to preach to the faithful for two days before expiring. May this Apostle increase our zeal for the Lord. St. Andrew, Pray for us.
