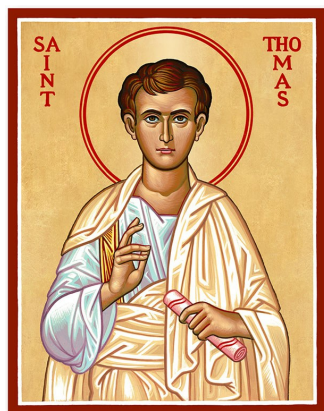


Feast of Saints Peter and Paul: On June 29th The Church looks back to her origin and celebrates the feast of the two most important men in her life who molded her in the early stages, leaving an indelible mark on her very foundation and character. Saints Peter and Paul are referred as the two pillars of the church, two lanterns burning for the way to heaven. St. Peter originally known as Simon, was a fisherman on the shore of Galilee. He was married and settled at Capernaum with his brother Andrew he earned his living fishing until the Lord called him to become a fisherman to become a fisher of men. Each patient carries his own doctor inside himself: The great missionary physician, Dr. Albert Schweitzer, said it simply and realistically: "Each patient carries his own doctor inside himself. They come to us [physicians] not knowing that truth. We are best when we give the doctor who resides within each patient a chance to work." — Are you giving the "doctor who resides" within you the chance to work? Are you giving the "doctor who resides" within your spouse, your child, your significant other, the chance to work? Here is a little self-administered test from a study by Dr. Carl Simonton. Answer these questions, yes

or no. Do you have a tendency to hold resentment? Yes or no. Would you rather carry a grudge than forgive? Yes or no. Would you rather cry in self-pity than invite a friend out for dinner? Yes or no. Do you have a problem developing and maintaining long-term relationships? Yes or no. Do you have a low self image? Yes or no. If you answer with more "yeses," by Dr. Simonton's test study, you are not giving the "doctor who resides within" you the best chance to work. A "yes" means you are most vulnerable to illness.



My Lord and My God: On July 3rd Church celebrates the feast of one of the most courageous Apostles and who made the most amazing profession of faith in the scripture "My Lord and My God" who is usually known as the doubting Thomas. St. Thomas, one of the 12 Apostles was born in Galilee in the 1st century. He was a simple fisherman by profession until Our Lord called him. A glimpse of Thomas' great love for his master is evident at the time when he was ready to accompany Jesus to the house where Lazarus had just died, though the other Apostles feared being stoned by the Jews in Judaea- Thomas said Let us go, that we may die with him (Lk 11: 16) It was his declaration at the last supper " Lord we do not know where you are going, to which Jesus said " I am the way, the truth and the life. (Jn 14: 6). Tradition say that he travelled to India in 52 AD and started Catholicism in

India. He is the Apostle of India. As we celebrate the feast of this courageous Apostle on July 3rd let us seek his intercession to be strong enough to live and profess our Faith in our word and deed of everyday.

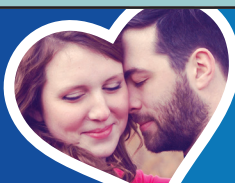
