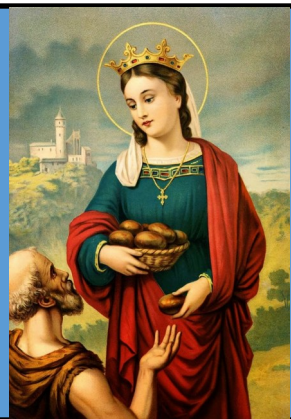

Eighteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

First Reading: Isaiah 55:1-3

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 145

Second Reading: Romans 8:35, 37-39

Gospel: Matthew 14:13-21

Key Theme: God's Generous Care

Focus: Trust in God

Summary: God invites everyone to receive his gifts. Jesus feeds the crowd, and Paul reminds us that nothing can separate us from Christ's love. God provides for his people and stays close to them.

Challenge: Trust God when needs seem greater than resources. Share what you have and care for those who are hungry or struggling.

Action Step: Look for one person who needs help this week. Share your time, kindness, or resources with them.

Verse to Remember: "Nothing will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 8:39)



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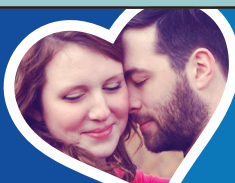
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
